Tarnovia Flute Summer - Tarnów 2024 - detailed and regulatory information

Flute summer school for students of primary and secondary music schools, students and graduates, conducted by outstanding artists from Poland and abroad. The event will take place in the building of the Ignacy Jan Paderewski Primary and Secondary Music School Complex in Tarnów.

Participation costs:

€200 cost of active participation, which includes: five individual lessons, including at least two with a foreign teacher piccolo flute playing classes chamber ensembles and flute choir concerts of teachers and participants classes with a physiotherapist permanent breathing technique instrument repair classes

NOTE: when registering by March 31, the cost of participation is €150 Note: the duration of one lesson is 45 minutes

Accommodation costs:

€200 accommodation with breakfast in summer houses for 2, 3, 4 people with separate bathrooms, kettle and fridge

€350 accommodation with breakfast in 2- or 3-person hotel rooms with a bathroom

€400 nights with full-board (breakfast, lunch and dinner) in summer houses for 2, 3 and 4 people with separate bathrooms, kettle and fridge

€450 nights with full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner) in hotel rooms for 2 or 3 people with a bathroom

06/07/2024 (Saturday) - departure day. Classes on this day last until the afternoon.

The Parent's or Guardian's stay is possible at the underage Participants' accommodation, the price depends on the selected option. Applications from Guardians are accepted when registering the Participant.

STATUTE

- 1. Participants under 18 years old of age may stay on the course only under the care of a parent or guardian (non-polish residence).
- 2. The organizer provides insurance against accidental events for the duration of the workshops.
- 3. The organizer reserves the right to change the program, and at the same time undertakes to ensure the highest possible substantive level of the workshops.
- 4. The organizer reserves the right to hold a competition for recordings to participate in classes with Jelka Weber and Mario Caroli. Participants will be informed about this by e-mail in May 2024.

REGULATIONS OF THE STAY:

- 1. It is forbidden to consume alcoholic beverages, drugs, intoxicants, vulgar behavior, starting quarrels, fights, or disturbing the peace of other course participants, under penalty of expulsion.

- 4. Quiet hours apply between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Course participants should stay in their own rooms, remain calm and do not play instruments.
- 5. Each participant of music courses should keep the room and its surroundings clean.
- 6. Each participant should take care of their personal belongings, instruments, money and documents.
- 7. The organizer is not responsible for damage or loss of participants' private belongings
- 8. The participant (parents or guardians) is financially responsible for any damage caused during the stay at the music course.
